DHS Summarizes COVID-19 CMS Emergency Declaration Blanket Waivers for Health care Providers Centers

DHS has issued <u>Provider Alert NF-20-75</u> as a summary of the proactive steps The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has taken under the 1135 Waiver process to temporarily waive certain nursing facility federal regulations in order to support aggressive efforts against COVID-19. The purpose of this alert is to provide a summary of the requirements that have been waived by CMS. **Facilities are responsible for reading all information outlined in the document released by CMS titled** <u>COVID-19</u> <u>Emergency Declaration Blanket Waivers for Health care Providers</u>. The following topics are addressed in the waiver. Please see the Provider Alert <u>here</u> for the summary.

- 3-Day Prior Hospitalization
- Reporting Minimum Data Set
- Staffing Data Submission
- Waive Pre-Admission Screening and Annual Resident Review (PASARR)
- Resident Groups
- Training and Certification of Nurse Aides
- Physician Visits in Skilled Nursing Facilities/Nursing Facilities
- Resident Transfer and Discharge

Note: There are exceptions to these waivers outlined in the CMS document. These waivers DO NOT require a request to be sent to the CMS Regional Office or that notification be made to any of CMS's regional offices.
