Dr. Kelly Tremblay, PhD, FAAA. Retired Professor and Audiologist, Founder of Lend an Ear, Consulting Contributor to the WHO's World Report on Ageing and Health and Co-author of the WHO's new guidelines on Integrated Care for Older People.

Dr. Tremblay worked as a tenured Professor of Neuroscience and Audiology at the University of Washington for more than 20 years, where she held the position as the Director of the Brain and Behavior Laboratory. She's also a contributor to The World Health Organization "World Report on Ageing and Health" published in 2015 and "Guidelines for Integrated Care for Older People" and its toolkit, published on October 1, 2019. She also judges research grants for the National Institutes of Health Communication Disorders Review Committee. Dr. Tremblay believes that advocacy and action are inseparable from one another. To that end, she offers coaching and consultancy to help the aging world stay productive and socially connected through technology and psychology.
