TIME SENSITIVE: Update and Feedback Requested on Nursing Home Point-of-Care Antigen Testing

Due to some reports from providers with concerns over possible false positive POC antigen test results tied primarily to the BD machine, national LeadingAge and AHCA are jointly asking nursing homes to complete a short survey on their antigen POC testing results. The survey can be accessed here and will close by midnight, today, September 15th. Members can email concerns over the use of the BD POC tests to: Technical Services@bd.com. BD also offers a microsite and training webinars, which members are encouraged to review if they are having concerns with accuracy to make sure they are properly following all instructions.

SOQ Issues Guidance for Evacuation Returns

Safety Oversight and Quality (SOQ) issued provider alert NF-20-122 providing guidance for facilities returning from evacuation due to the wildfires. Facilities in Level 2 evacuation zones should receive approval from their county emergency manager prior to moving back into their facilities to make sure it is safe to return. SOQ recommends that facilities consider all evacuated residents potentially exposed and use conservative infection control strategies that facilities have been implemented during this pandemic to limit the spread of COVID-19. Proposed Medicaid Fiscal Accountability Regulation (MFAR) Withdrawn

CMS announced yesterday afternoon that they will not move forward with the proposed Medicaid Fiscal Accountability Regulation (MFAR). If finalized, MFAR would have jeopardized key nursing home financing policies, including life plan community provider tax exemptions and nursing home supplemental payment programs. LeadingAge strongly opposed the proposal and worked closely with our state partners and members to urge CMS to withdraw MFAR.
